In the meantime, another event that will bring joy and a sense of normality to our community is KS3 & Year 10 Sports Day. This will take place on Monday 19th July:

- All students, including Year 10 who normally start later, should arrive promptly for an 8.20am start.
- All students should arrive in kit at 08:20am. Kit is full Southfields PE kit t-shirt, black shorts/trousers and trainers.
- Students are encouraged to bring their own lunch. Each year group will have access to the canteen for 40 minutes at set times throughout the day which means they can buy food and water if required.
- All students should bring a water bottle. There will be movement around the site throughout the day giving opportunities to refill.
- Students will remain in their own year group bubbles throughout the day.
- Students will be dismissed at 1.20pm.

Easing of Restrictions

With announcements about restrictions being eased, we have yet to receive the detail from the Department for Education about how the school day and school site will look from September.
