
# Plans for the remainder of year 11

# Last day of face-to-face lessons for year 11 students - Friday, 28th May:

# Year 11 Leavers' Event and preparation for KS5/ post-16 - Tue 29th June, (Time TBC):

Although we will be unable to host parents/ carers for this event, we still intend to make this special for the students - they deserve it! The event will consist of a carousel of careers activities followed by an outdoor ceremony, distribution of their Record of Achievement Folder and their '2021 Leavers' hoodies, a BBQ and some music! ### **Careers and Virtual Work Experience:**
