Dear Parent/Carer

As promised in my letter of last week, I am writing with details regarding the arrangements for the end of term this week and the new term in January.

### End of Term

The last day of term for all students is this **Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> December 2021**. All students will be dismissed at the end of the school day.

### Spring Term Arrangements

As mentioned previously, we are required to test students for Covid before they return to lessons in school. This means that there will be a staggered start to the beginning of the new term but all students should be back in full time lessons by Monday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2022.

The staggered start in the week of 5<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> January means that students are either

- working at home on Google Classrooms; or
- coming into school for Covid testing only, then going home directly; or
- returning to full-time lessons if they test negative.

If you have not completed a consent form for your child (further details below), please do not send them in on their year group's testing day – they should continue with work on Google Classrooms at home. Below are the arrangements for your child:

	Tutor groups: 7GRH, 7GTD, 7MMA, 7NYR Arrive 9.00am – back gate Testing from 9.30am Leave site 10.45am-11.15am
Week commencing Monday 10 <sup>th</sup> January 2022	Normal school day resumes.

### Testing

If you have not yet done so, please confirm whether you give consent for your child to be tested or not on their return to school by [completing this form](#). Please do fill it in as any forms not completed means that we have to phone parents which may delay the testing programme and have an impact on when the normal school day for your child can resume.

Students will be testing themselves, supported by staff, using the tests requiring a nasal swab only. Throat swabs will not be needed. Once tested, all students will be sent home, as outlined above. Parents of those students who test positive will be notified so that they can arrange a PCR test for their child. These students will need to remain at home until the result of this is received and if it is a positive result, your child will need to isolate.
