Dear Parent/Carer

We are now two-thirds of the way through the academic year and our students have accomplished much since September. Having operated under various restrictions for so long, it has been so good for the community to arrive at a new version of normality in which students can once again flourish and make uninterrupted progress in their education.

Covid

We are mindful that Covid is still a reality though and remains present in our community. The Department for Education has issued updated guidance, effective 1st April, which advises:

- Children and young people who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can go back to school, college or childcare when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend
- Adults with a positive COVID-19 test result should try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days, which is when they are most infectious. For children and young people aged 18 and under, the advice will be 3 days.

If your child is unwell, please do follow the DfE guidance and notify our absence line on 020 8875 2634 or via natalie.stearn@southfieldsacademy.com We have recently seen the highest levels of Covid amongst our staff and students since the pandemic began. This has impacted on all but, due to the systems we have in place, we have been able to provide all lessons to our students and, where a teacher has been absent, cover has been provided by another member of teaching staff or one of our team of specialist Cover Supervisors.
